Word	Part of speech	Meaning
adjustments	<i>n</i> [C/U]	small changes made to correct or improve something
approval	<i>n</i> [C/U]	agreement to or permission for something (e.g., a plan or request)
budget	<i>n</i> [C/U], <i>v</i> [T/I]	noun: the money available to a person or company and the plan for how it will be used over a period of time verb: to be careful about the amount of money you spend; to plan to spend a set amount of money on a particular purchase
build	<i>n</i> [C/U], <i>v</i> [T/I]	noun: a version of a piece of software verb: to make something by putting parts together
deadline	<i>n</i> [C]	the time by which something must be done
deliverable	<i>n</i> [C], <i>adj</i>	noun: a product that a company promises to have ready for a customer adjective: that can be delivered
execute	<i>v</i> [T/I]	to do a piece of work or put a plan into action
expectation	<i>n</i> [C/U]	the belief that something is likely to happen
manage	<i>v</i> [T/I]	to be in charge of or to control a business, team, etc.
plan	<i>n</i> [C], <i>v</i> [T/I]	noun: something that you intend to do or achieve verb: to make detailed arrangements for something you want to do in the future; to make an outline or design for something
process	<i>n</i> [C], <i>v</i> [T/I]	noun: a series of things which are done in a particular order to achieve a result verb: to perform a series of operations on data in a computer
scheduling	<i>n</i> [U]	planning the times at which particular tasks will be done or events will happen
