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information /ˌɪnfə'meɪʃn/ *n* [U] facts about a person, situation, event or plans: *I would like some more information about the programming course.*

inform /ɪn'fɔ:m/ *v* [T] to tell somebody facts: *The lecturer informed us that the assignment would be more difficult than usual.*

informed /ɪn'fɔ:md/ *adj* having information or knowledge: *The university sends regular emails to keep us informed of what is happening on our course.*

informative /ɪn'fɔ:mətɪv/ *adj* providing useful information: *The course book was very informative.*

informatics /ˌɪnfə'mætɪks/ *n* [U] the study of systems that store, process and communicate information: *There are many job opportunities in healthcare informatics.*

informational /ˌɪnfə'meɪʃənl/ *adj* containing information: *The centre was set up to meet the informational needs of the students.*
